Sub:- Sanction of Commutation of Pension to the State Govt. Pensioners.

Sir,

With reference to the correspondence resting with your D.O. letter No.PE-1/State pen policy/Vol-II/06-07/896 dated 7-2-2008 addressed to the Chief Secretary to the Govt. of Assam on the subject mentioned above and to say that the commutation of pension to the State Government Employees, on application by Govt. servant is Governed by the Assam service (commutation of pension) Rule, 1965. Commutation of pension is optional. It is sanctioned subject to the condition that the expenditure can be made from the budget grant only as per Rule 3 of the aforesaid Rule.

Sanction of Commutation of pension is limited to the availability of fund in the budget. Due to financial constraint, sanction of commutation of pension could not be made to all the pensioners in favour of whom Admissibility, Report were received from Accountant General, Assam in respect of teaching and non-teaching retired employees of the Schools. Government has taken utmost care to streamline the process of sanction commutation of pension by providing Budget provision. As on 31-3-2008. P & P.G. Department have cleared cases of commutation of pension of the pensioners on the basis of Admissibility reports received from Accountant General, Assam and Director of pension, Assam up to Oct.,2007 barring few Non-medical and Medical cases.

It will be appreciated that the present system of sanction of commutation of pension as per provision of the Assam Services (commutation pension) Rule, 1965 is most suitable in the present context Government desires that the process of commutation or pension, hitherto prevailing, should be maintained.

The upto-date position of sanction of commutation of pension against the pensioners as per your letter is appended herewith for your information.
