**NOTIFICATION  
ORDERS BY THE GOVERNOR OF ASSAM**

Dated Dispur, the 12<sup>th</sup> February, 2013

No.PPG(P)366/2011/32 : In exercise of the powers by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India the Governor of Assam is hereby pleased make the following rules further to amend the Assam Services (Commutation of Pension) Rules, 1965, here-in-after to as the principal Rules, namely :-

Short title,  
Commencement

1. (1) These rule may be called the Assam Services (Commutation of Pension) (Amendment) Rules, 2013.
- (2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on and from 01/01/2013.
- (3) They shall be applicable to the Government servant who retires on or after 1/1/2013. The government servant who retired before 1/1/2013 will continue to be governed by the existing Rule 17 and the table for calculation of commuted value of pension bearing interest @ ₹ 4.75 per annum.

Insertion of new rule 17A

2. In the principal Rules after the existing rule 17, the following new rule 17 A shall be inserted namely:-  
  
“17 A. The Government servant who retires on or after 1/1/2013 the lump sum payable to them on commutation value of pension shall be calculated in accordance with the table Annexur-1A bearing interest at the rate 8% per annum limiting the quantum of commutation value at 33.33% of the basic pension. The full pension will be restored after 14 (fourteen) years if the pensioner survives”.
