Sub:- Regarding relief to employed family pensioners/superannuation pension holders.

A reference is invited to this Department's Office Memorandum No. PPG(P)151/04//14 dated 29-01-2011 on the subject cited above according to which no relief will be admissible to any State Govt. family pensioner if he/she is an employee of the State/Central Govt./State, Central Govt. Undertakings, corporations or autonomous body receiving grants in aid from the Central/State Govt.

It is now clarified that no relief will be admissible to any State Govt./Central Govt.'s family pensioner who is also receiving superannuation pension from State/Central Govt. In such case relief will be admissible only towards his/her superannuation pension like other State/Central Govt. pensioners.
