Sir,

I am directed to say that the Accountant General (A & E), Assam has informed that Final Withdrawal claim of GPF subscribers of Govt. of Assam are forwarded to Accountant General after a considerable gap of retirement/death. As a result, the Govt. have to pay interest up to six months in accordance to Rules 13(4) of GPF(AS) Rules, 1937 for delay in submission of Final Withdrawal claims by most of the Administrative Department.

You are therefore requested to direct all the Head of Offices working under your control to obtain and forward the Final Withdrawal claim of GPF subscribers under his control in due time to Accountant General as per provision of Rule 31 of GPF (AS) Rules, 1937.
