Dated Dispur, the 8<sup>th</sup> June, 1989.

NO. AR.29/88/43 – In the interest of public services and administrative convenience, the Governor of Assam is pleased to order the creation of the “Directorate of Pension ‘under the administrative control of the Pension and Public Grievances Department with immediate effect, to deal with matters relating to pension and other retirement benefits of the teaching and non- teaching employees of the provincialised schools under the State Government. The status of the Directorate will be of a Level-II Head of Department and it’s headquarter will at present be at Guwahati.

The functions of the Directorate will be ----

- (i) to issue Pensions Payment Order to the retired Teaching and Non- Teaching employees or provincialised schools including issue of family pension to the family of such deceased persons.
- (ii) authorisation of payment of Gratuity including Death-cum- Retirement Gratuity to the retired Teaching and Non- Teaching employees of provincialised schools.
- (iii) authorisation of payment of commutation of pension to the retired Teaching and Non-Teaching employees of provincialised schools.
