OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject :- Grant of Dearness relief to the State Government Pensioners and Family Pension holders, Extra-Ordinary Pensioners and Extra-Ordinary Family Pension holders.

In continuation of this Deptt's O.M. NO.PPG(P)38/91/26 dt.6.3.92 in the matter of dearness relief to retired Government Servants and holders of Family Pensions and extra-ordinary Pensioners and extra-ordinary family pension holders in respect of deceased Government servants/Pensioners, the Governor of Assam is pleased to grant dearness relief at the enhanced rates indicated below to all the Assam government pensioners, Family Pensioners, Extra-ordinary Pensioners and Extra-ordinary Family Pensioners irrespective of their date of retirement/death with effect from the date and period as shown below.

It issues with concurrence of finance (A&F) Deptt. Vide their U/O No. FM.757/92 dt.5/11/92.

1.2 The relief will also be admissible on the Provisional Pension upto the validity of the Provisional Pension vide Finance (A&F) Deptt's letter No. FMP.30/86/21, dt.17.1.87.

1.3 The dues from 1/9/92 onwards as per these rates are to be paid now. Separate Govt. instruction will be issued later regarding the payment of the arrear dues upto 31/8/92 as per these revised rates.

1.4 Payment on account of Dearness Relief involving fraction of 50 Paise and above may be rounded off to the next higher rupee and fraction of less than 50 paise may be ignored.

2. The Treasuries and Sub-Treasuries in Assam/All Authorized public Sector Banks are requested to arrange payment of dearness relief to Pensioners on the basis of above instructions immediately.

3. One set of Ready Reckoner, showing the revised Dearness Relief for the period from 1/1/92 to 30/6/92 and another set of Ready Reckoner for the period from 1/7/92 onwards have been prepared and copies of the same are enclosed for all Treasuries/Sub-Treasuries in Assam, concerned Public Sector Banks, Accountant General, Assam, Finance Deptt., Supdt. of Assam Govt. Press, Resident Commissioner, govt. of Assam, New Delhi, Trade Adviser, Govt. of Assam, Calcutta etc.
