Whereas Hon'ble Gauhati high Court, vide judgment dated **24-03-2010** passed in connection with **Writ Appeal No. 145 of 2009** has directed the Government of Assam to pay pension and to make available other retiral benefits to the Provincialised Panchayat Employees in terms of the **Assam Panchayat Employee (Provinciaisation) Act, 1999**, and the Pension Rules applicable to the Government Employees of the State of Assam:

Now, in terms of the judgment, referred above, the Governor of Assam is pleased to order that the benefits of the Provision of the Assam Panchayat Employees (Provincialisation) Act, 1999, including those for pension and other retirement dues applicable to the State Government Employees, would be available to the Provincialised Panchayat Employees **who were in service on or after 01-10-1991 on the basis of the length of their service reckoned from the date(s) of their appointment in the service of Panchayats.**

These issue with the concurrence of Finance (EC-I) Department vide their endorsement did 11.3.2011 at page No. 84 with reference to the endorsement referred by Panchayat and Rural Development Department dtd. 7.1.2011 at page -142 in file No-PDA 246/2003.
