ORDERS BY THE GOVERNOR OF ASSAM
OFFICE MEMORANDUM

NO.PPG(P)273/2012/2

Dated Dispur, the 11th Sept,2012.

It has come to the notice of the Govt. that pension papers of the pensioners are being forwarded to the A.G. (A&E) Assam/Director Pension, Assam as the case may be by most of the departments/Heads of Deptts/Heads of Offices (Controlling Officers) without following the proper guidelines as provided in A.S.(P) Rules 1969 issued by the Govt. from time to time.

As a result some defects and deficiencies are detected at the time of scrutiny of the pension papers and service book by the office of A.G. (A&E) Assam and the Director of Pension Assam for which these are required to return to the pension papers forwarding authority for resubmission of the same after correction.

This cause undue delay for settlement of pension cases, family pension cases causing undue hardship to the pensioners. In some cases Govt. is to face in embarrassing situation and sometimes Govt. have to compensate the pensioners because of the interference of Hon'ble High Court.

Under the above circumstances Govt. in the P &PG Deptt. have expressed grave concern for such delay in payment of pension/family pension inspite of clear guidelines and instructions as contained in Govt. OM No.FPC/SC/91/76/5 dated 29/04/1976, Notification No.PPG(P) 254/93/85 dated 29/10/1999 and OM No. PPG(P) 317/2011/10 dated 26.09.2011 issued by P&PG Deptt.

In view of this, P & PG Deptt. felt it imperative to remind all concerned to follow the guidelines as state above carefully for its strict adherence while forwarding the pension papers/family pension papers to the A.G. (A&E) Assam and the D.P. Assam and the D.P. Assam as the case may be for final disposal so that pensioners/Family pensioners shall not face any financial hardship for settlement of their pension cases as well as to avoid further complicacy.
