**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

Subject : The pensionary benefit to the State Government Pensioners / Family pension holders.

In the Govt. of Assam circular issued under office Memorandum No.FMP.48/83/40 dtd. 10-8-63 of Finance (APF) Deptt. a temporary Govt. employee, who retires after rendering temporary service of not less than 20 years under the Government without being confirmed in any post is to be allowed the pensionary benefits as available to a retiring confirmed Government employee either on attaining the age of superannuation or on his being declared to be permanently incapacitated for further Government service by the appropriated medical authority. The said O.M. came into force with effect from 01<sup>st</sup> September, 1982.

The Governor of Assam is now pleased to clarify that all temporary Government employees who have retired from the service under the Governor of Assam fulfilling the criteria of not less than 20 (twenty) years of continuous service will be eligible for pension from 01<sup>st</sup> September, 1982 onwards. This is, however, subject to the condition that they satisfy all conditions other than the condition of permanency against permanent posts under the Govt. of Assam for usual pensioner benefit under the Assam Services (Pension) Rules, 1969. This benefit not be admissible to any retirees who retire from service with retirement benefits under CPF Rules.

**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

Sub : Reference from Administrative Deptts. to  
consulting Deptt. procedure thereof.

It has been observed that the administrative departments refer cases/files to Pension & Public Grievances Department for approval/concurrence in the matter of Pension & P.G. Deptt. are required. Even in most of the cases, Deptt. fail to submit précis of the case. It is also observed that endorsement of Pension & Public Grievances Deptt. is mostly vague in one or two lines without specifying the issues on which views/concurrence of Pension & P.G. Deptt. will necessary. As a result, Pension & P.G. Deptt. have to return the file to the concerned Department to clarify the points(s) or to submit précis of the case, which in turn, take lot of time in finally disposing of the file. Henceforth, Pension & P.G. Deptt. will not take action on the files where a mere approval of the Commissioner & Secretary/Secretary of the Administrative Deptt. has been taken only for moving Pension & P.G. Deptt. but not accompanied by detailed not & précis of the matter.

The Administrative Deptt. are once again requested to move Pension & P.G. Deptt. for their views/approval etc. while endorsing their files with a self contained note/a signed précis of the case to facilitate prompt disposal by the Pension & Public Grievances Department.
