OFFICE MEMORANDUM

The 25th September, 2006

No. PPG (G)56/2006/12. - It has come to the notice of the Government that confusion has arisen in the minds of some implementing authorities as to the applicability of the Government letter No. FMP50/85/267 dated 5th Sept., 1980 regarding relief to employed Special Family Pension Holder(s) who are the next of kin of the deceased Government servant, killed/died as a result of attack by extremist, anti-social elements etc. while performing duties or during action against dacoits, smugglers, hostiles or other elements while discharging his Government duties. Relief as admissible to normal Family Pension is NOT admissible from the date, the Special Family Pension is

Granted. Any new instalment of relief, effective from the date after the grant of Special Family Pension will be admissible to the Special Family Pension Holder(s).

Special Family Pension Holder(s), if he/she is an employee of the State/Central Government, State/Central Undertaking, Corporation or Autonomous Bodies receiving grants-in-aid from the State/Central Government is/are entitled to get any new instalments of relief granted and effective from any date after the grant of Special Family Pension till the date of actual superannuation of the deceased Government servant. Thereafter, family pension as admissible to normal Family Pensionees under the Assam Services (Pension) Rules 1969 would be payable to the Special Family Pension Holder(s).

Special Family Pension will be sanctioned by the Administrative Department with the approval of the Pension and Public Grievances Department. Government of India's clearance will be necessary for extending this benefit to the All India Services personnel.

No.PPG(P)103/2006/Part/2.- Immediately on taking employment, pensioners of the State Government including family pensioners should intimate this fact to the Pension Disbursing Authorities. The pensioner including Family Pensioner is not to wait for the month of May or November when the submission of half yearly Certificate becomes due.

No relief is paid by the Pension Disbursing Authority (Including Treasury Officers/Public Sector Banks) to the re-employed Pensioner including family pensioner during the period of re-employment. After the spell of re-employment ceases payment of relief will be revived by the same Authority without the intervention of the Accountant General and/or the Authority under whom the pensioner was re-employed. For this purpose, however the pensioner including family pensioner is required to furnish half yearly Certificates in the month of May or November in the form prescribed in the Rules about Non-re-employment to the pension Disbursing Authority or the facts about his/her status of being re-employed. In the latter case, he/she must furnish particulars of his/her re-employment, i.e. names of the Government/Department/Office/Corporation/Autonomous Bodies/Council etc. as the case may be.

In order that cases of re-employment of Pensioners including Family Pensioner are reported promptly to the Pension Disbursing Authorities and this information is not withheld by the pensioners, intentionally or otherwise, all the re-employing Departments/Organisations may obtain details of the PPOs and Designations of the Pension Disbursing Authority from whom the

re-employing pensioners receive pension and send to the Pension Disbursing Authority by registered post intimating the fact of re-employment date thereof and monthly rates of emoluments.

The above instructions may be brought to the notice of all Subordinate Offices, Government Undertaking, Corporations, Autonomous Bodies under the Administrative Control of all State Government Departments.
